

## Solid Waste Collection

Household trash pickup and recycling is included as part of the monthly HOA assessment. We are currently contracting with the Lion's Club Services, Inc. for these services. Guidelines for these services are noted below.

### Lion's Club Waste Pick up Guidelines

#### Solid Waste

There is a 99-gallon limit on trash per week that includes household, kitchen and bathroom waste. (Special pickup service is available for certain items at the homeowner's expense.) Use plastic trash bags for solid waste as trash cans are not provided. If you choose to use you own trash can do not mix trash bags with recycling bags.

Absolutely NO yard vegetation is allowed in the solid waste. This is a Henderson County rule that the Lion's Club Services, Inc. enforces.

#### Recycling

Recycling is picked up every other week. Recycling must be bagged except for corrugated cardboard. You can use a box to contain recycling and other boxes. Use blue bags to differentiate from solid waste. Don't make it heavy. There is no limit on the amount of recycling.

The Lion's Club follows the Henderson County directions for what can be recycled. Cardboard (no pizza boxes); mixed paper that hasn't been in contact with food; plastic bottles and jugs without lids; tin and steel soup and vegetable cans; and aluminum drink cans are all recyclable.

#### Schedule

Refer to the calendar at <http://etowahlionssservices.com/> for recycling dates, follow the **purple** schedule. Trash pickup is on Tuesdays. Trash will not be picked up on the following holidays: New Year's Day, Martin Luther King Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day. Holidays falling on a Monday or Tuesday, will cause our pickup day to move to Wednesday. Holidays occurring after Tuesday will not change our pickup day.
